On behalf of Governor Andrew M. Cuomo, I am pleased to inform you that your community has been awarded a NYS Water Infrastructure Improvement Act (WIIA) grant for the above referenced project.

Your WIIA grant has been awarded in an amount not to exceed \$3,062,500, based on information provided in your application, including total estimated eligible project costs. The Environmental Facilities Corporation (EFC) will determine the actual amount of your grant when the project is complete and EFC confirms the final project costs. Your grant may be reduced if total project costs are less than anticipated, or if your project receives grant from another source.

Please confirm your acceptance of the grant award and intent to proceed with this project by completing and signing the enclosed form and e-mailing it to <a href="mailto:nyswatergrants@efc.ny.gov">nyswatergrants@efc.ny.gov</a> no later than **December 7, 2018**. Upon receipt of your confirmation, members of our EFC team will contact you to guide you through the program requirements and grant process and to answer any of your questions.
