Mayor Newhard read the following email from Raymond and Lugene Maher that was submitted prior to the Village Board meeting:

We attended the Work Session held on Dec. 29th to discuss the Village View subdivision application.

While we expected the work session to provide an accurate and complete overview of the development, we were extremely disappointed by the blatant display of bias in favor of the developer and "Plan B". The work session failed to provide the facts in a fair and balanced manner. Rather, the discussion and overview left out important safety, conservation, and infrastructure deficiencies with "Plan B' and failed to highlight a single, positive attribute of 'Plan A', of which there are several. The Work Session left everyone questioning what the real purpose and intent of the meeting was because it certainly appeared that it was meant to produce a particular outcome in favor of 'Plan B' for reasons that may serve the Village Board, the Village Planning Board, and most certainly the developer.

Discussion

Mayor Newhard stated he felt the work session had a balanced representation. The work session was a moment when the Board of Trustees had the ability to have a discussion with, Village Attorney, Stephen Gaba, Village Engineers, Lehman & Getz, and the Chairman of the Planning Board, James Patterson. Mayor Newhard felt the overview did not come off as bias. Mayor Newhard stated that if the Maher's would like to submit information to the Village Board as to why Plan A is significantly better to please share that information to the Board of Trustees for review.
