1. That effective immediately the Village of Warwick shall suspend the practice of termination of water service for failure to pay utility bills when due, including issuance of notices by the Village of potential termination of water service;

of the Village Board;	and
3.	The temporary suspension of the practice of termination of water service
for failure to pay utili	ty bills shall not in any way signify any suspension or waiver of the
