


**VILLAGE OF WARWICK
DECLARATION OF LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY
AND LOCAL EMERGENCY ORDER**

On January 23, 2026, the Governor of New York declared a State of Emergency for the entire State in response to the projected massive winter snowstorm and extreme cold temperatures. These conditions imperil public safety and pose an imminent threat of damage and injury to life or property.

Pursuant to the powers vested in me by New York State Executive Law § 24, as Chief Executive of the Village of Warwick, I hereby declare a State of Emergency exists in the Village of Warwick. This State of Emergency is to protect public health, safety, life and property and will continue until the emergency conditions are brought under control, but not to exceed five (5) days. The Village of Warwick has contacted State, County, and Town officials to coordinate emergency relief measures and has requested assistance.

By virtue of the powers vested in me as Mayor of the Village of Warwick and pursuant to New York State Executive Law § 24, I hereby issue this Local Emergency Order. This Order recognizes it is necessary and authorizes the entry of government personnel and equipment onto private lands to the extent necessary to provide safe passage for emergency vehicles to access residences. This Order prohibits on-street parking for the duration of the snowstorm, to allow for adequate plowing of Village streets. During the snowstorm period, no vehicles, other than emergency or storm-related vehicles, should be traveling on Village of Warwick streets.

This Order shall take effect immediately and shall cease to be in effect five (5) days after promulgation.
