Comments:

The Department has received the above referenced site plan and has found no evidence that significant intermunicipal or countywide impacts would result from its approval. We have no objection regarding the Village assuming Lead Agency status for this project. We would like to offer the following advisory comments:

<u>Environmental Constraints</u>: The proposed project is in an area known to contain habitat suitable for endangered or threatened species, including the Bog Turtle and the Indiana Bat. We advise the Town and the applicant to ensure that best practices are followed during construction, in order to minimize any accidental takings of these species. Best practices are likely to include times for tree harvesting, among other measures.

<u>Historic and Archeological Resources</u>: Wawayanda Creek flows approximately 520' east of the project site. Although the creek has no direct path over the project site, there is the possibility that the site contains historic or archeological resources from indigenous settlements nearby. Any such artifacts discovered during earthwork for the proposed parking area should be logged, and the Village may wish to require that the applicant obtain a letter from the New York State Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation regarding this project.
